- Legal Contracts

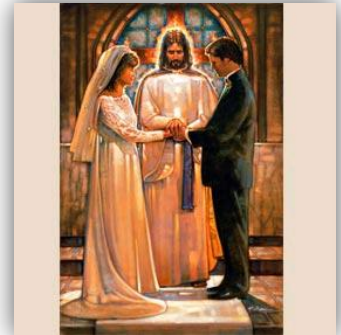


- May be severed legally

- Covenant with God



- Sacramental
- Cannot be severed by man
- "Till death do us part."

Civil marriage

Man + Woman \approx 1

$\frac{1}{2} + \frac{1}{2} \approx$ whole

*Even if use $1 + 1 = 2$,
still may be separated into two separate individuals*

Marriage = civil union

Legal Contract

May be separated and all materials divided evenly

depending on the state,

Woman + Woman \approx I

May be broken and
legally divided



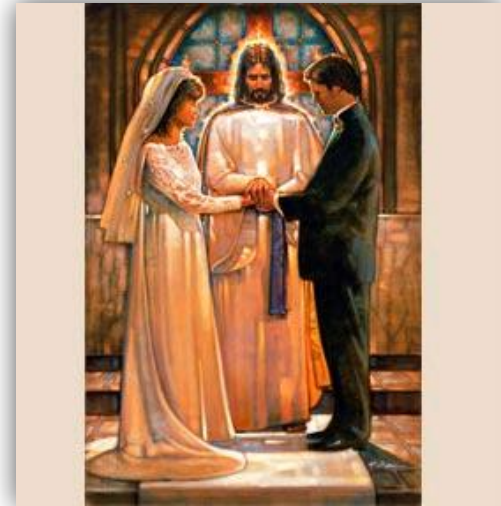
Man + Man \approx I

Christian Marriage

(I) * (I) * Christ = Spiritual and Physical Union

Union

Holy Matrimony

[(Union) * Christ] = Sacramental Union

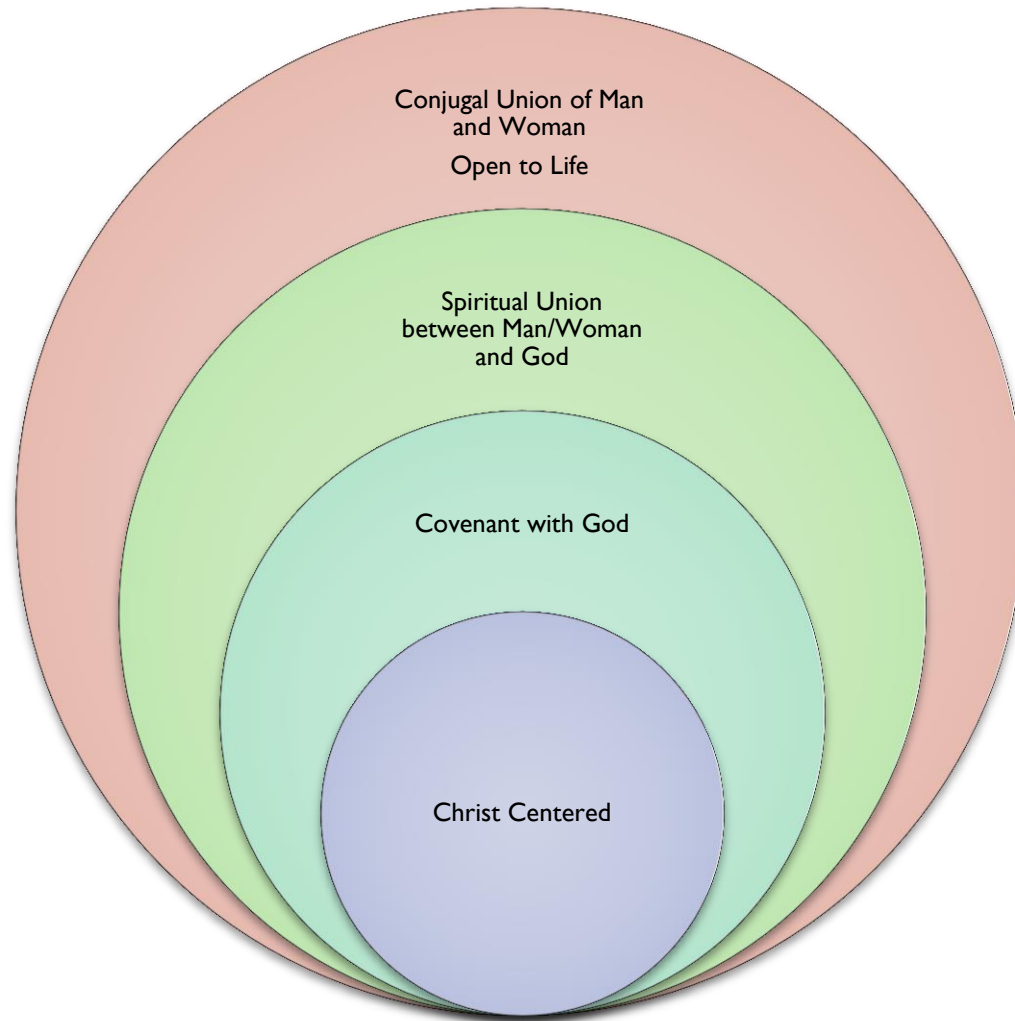
= Matrimony

NO MAN may put asunder.”*

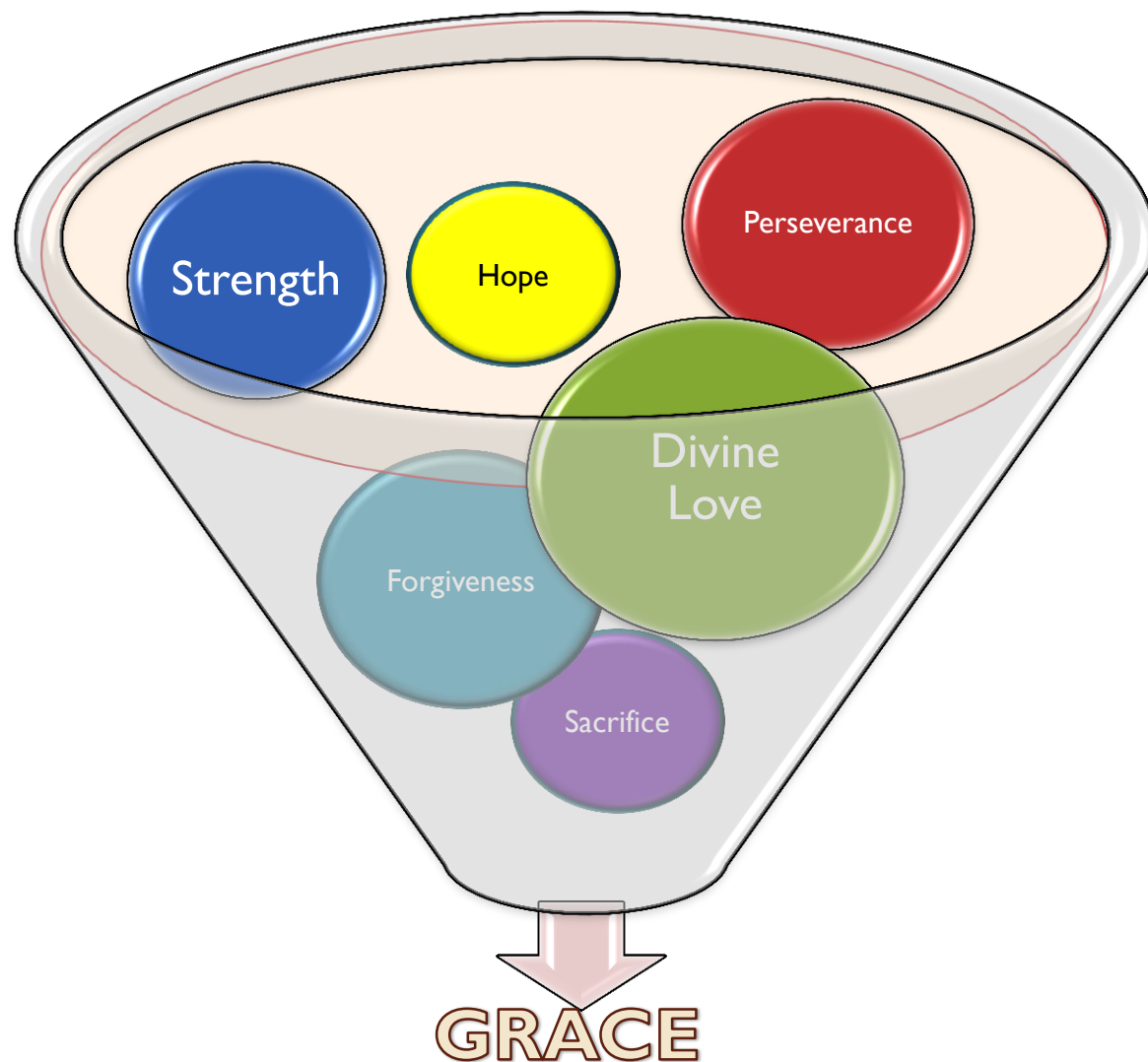
“Till death do us part.”

Sacramental Union

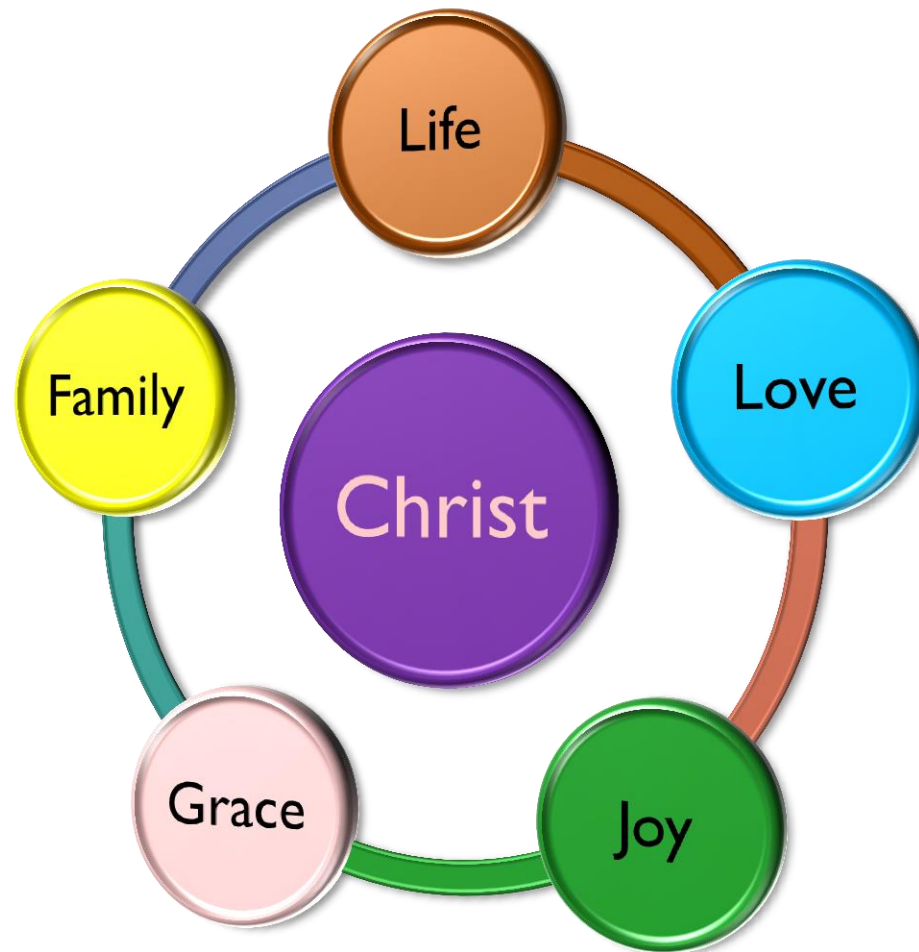


“till death do us part”

Adultery

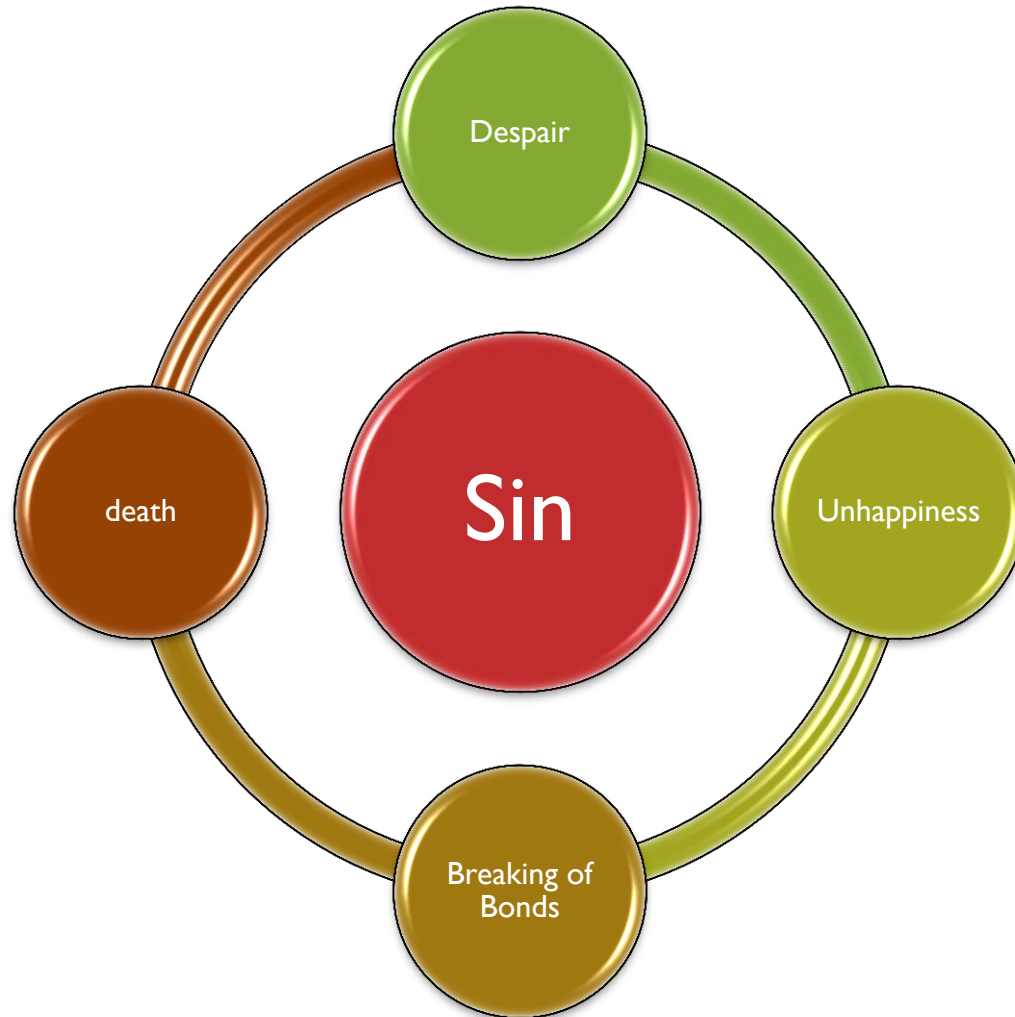
All extramarital Unions

Contraception

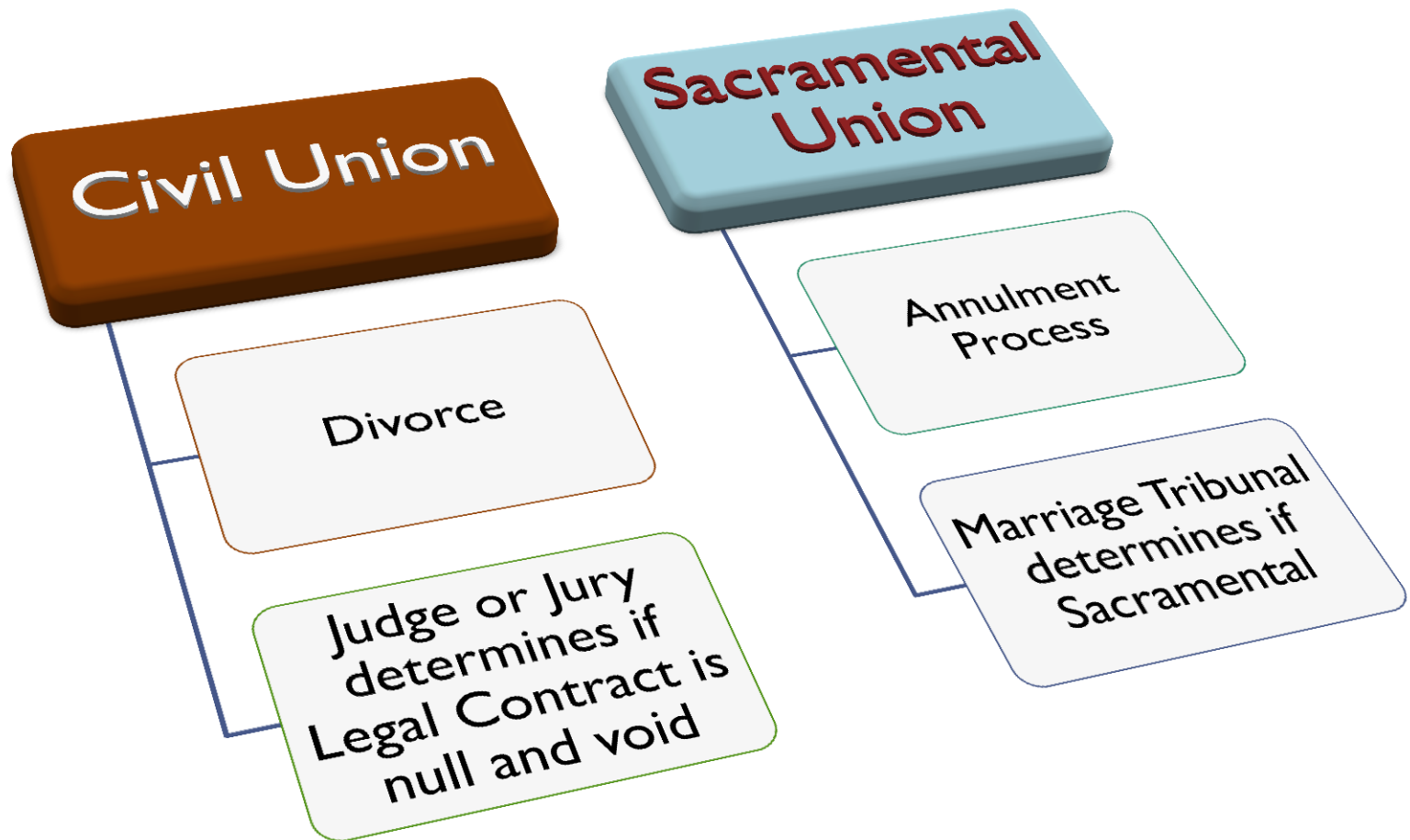
$$(\text{Sin}) = \emptyset = \text{Null}$$

$$(I) * (I) * (\text{Sin}) = \emptyset$$

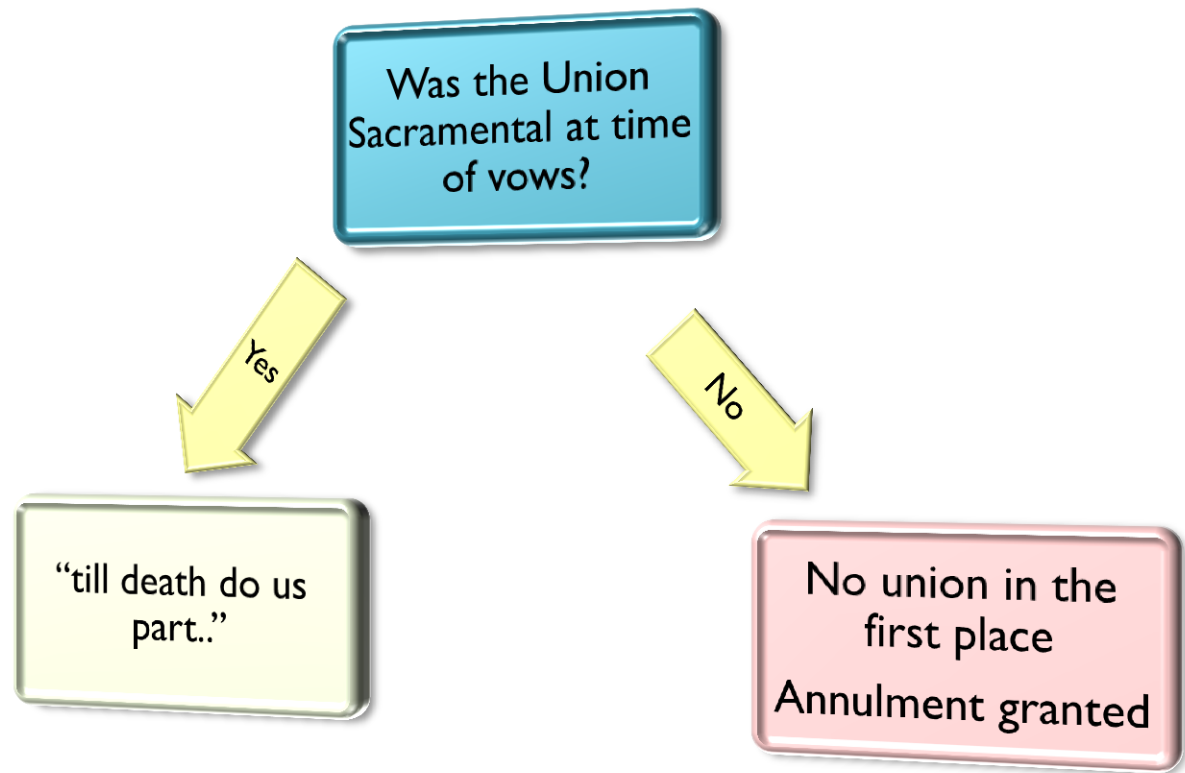
Fruit of the Union with Sin
